I recognize that it is the policy of *Steel River Playhouse* to require that any camper who participates in any program or activity of Steel River Playhouse be adequately covered by a personal or family medical plan which fully covers the camper from any injuries resulting from participation in said activity or program, including transportation to and from the place of activity, and, accordingly, I represent that the Registrant is adequately covered by a personal or family medical plan which includes coverage for hospitalization, medical expenses, and other related expenses which may arise from the Registrant's participation in the activities at Steel River Playhouse, and that I shall present proof of said coverage if necessary. I authorize *Steel River Playhouse* to use any photographs and/or media recordings in which the Registrant appears, for any purpose including but not limited to promotional purposes and release via the internet and/or other media outlets, without further notice, permission, or compensation. I hereby grant *Steel River Playhouse* (and their officers, employees, agents, volunteers, independent contractors, and Board members), permission, in their discretion, to release medical information to the program staff or others deemed necessary and in the interests of the Registrant, and to seek and authorize emergency medical treatment for the Registrant, and I hereby agree to assume all medical costs incurred. BY SIGNING THE ABOVE YOU ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THE FOLLOWING POLICIES ARE IN PLACE:

- **Classes with less than six students enrolled may have a delayed start date until sufficient enrollment can be found for a class, or students may be asked to merge with another similar class.** Steel River Playhouse reserves the right to change instructors, shift dates, change, withdraw or modify classes, workshops and lessons based on the availability of instructors or insufficient enrollment. Make sure to spread the word so that we have enough enrolment to run a class!
- **We run our Academic Year in three 12-week semesters that are broken down into 12 week, 10 week and 8 week sessions, in addition to a full summer program of three two-week camps, and summer production workshops that run on independent schedules.** Each of our academic semesters ends in a RECITAL for private lesson and group dance, and some group voice and acting classes. All classes end in either an opportunity to perform in a recital on the 12th week, or perform in-class during the regular classroom time of the 12th week – check with your instructor to find out whether your class performs in the recital or on your class day! The 12th week is also a week where makeups can be held, if necessary.
- **Production Workshops** run around production dates and do not always begin and end on the semester calendar schedule, usually including at least 12 classes, plus a full week of tech/dress rehearsals. Due to the quick nature of the production workshop (12 full rehearsals, solo work sessions and six days of tech), attendance is critical. Students are urged to attend all classes, and tech week is mandatory.
